

THE DANGERS OF USING GLUE TRAPS

Glue traps are inhumane and result in suffering and painful death

OVERVIEW

Trapped animals will die slowly from exposure, dehydration, starvation, suffocation, or predation



IMPACTS

Less than 60% of reported glue trap cases survive to be released back to the wild

Trapped wildlife must be transported to a professional wildlife veterinarian for care



ALTERNATIVES

Safe alternatives include exclusion, catch-and-release traps, ultrasonic repellents, and installation of owl perches and nesting boxes
