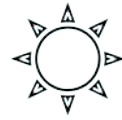




"Whoos Awake?"

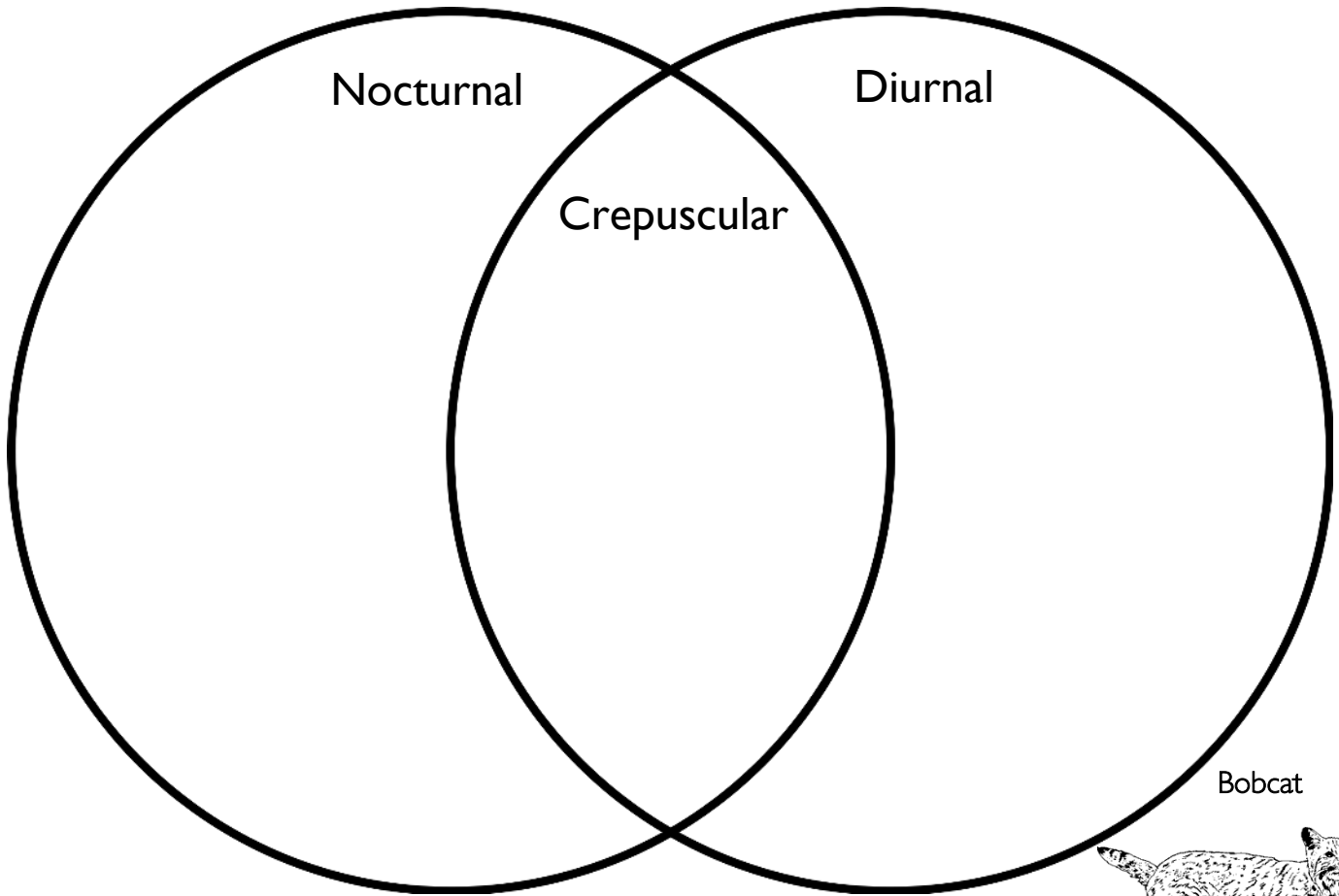


Depending on what time it is, you might see very different animals outside.

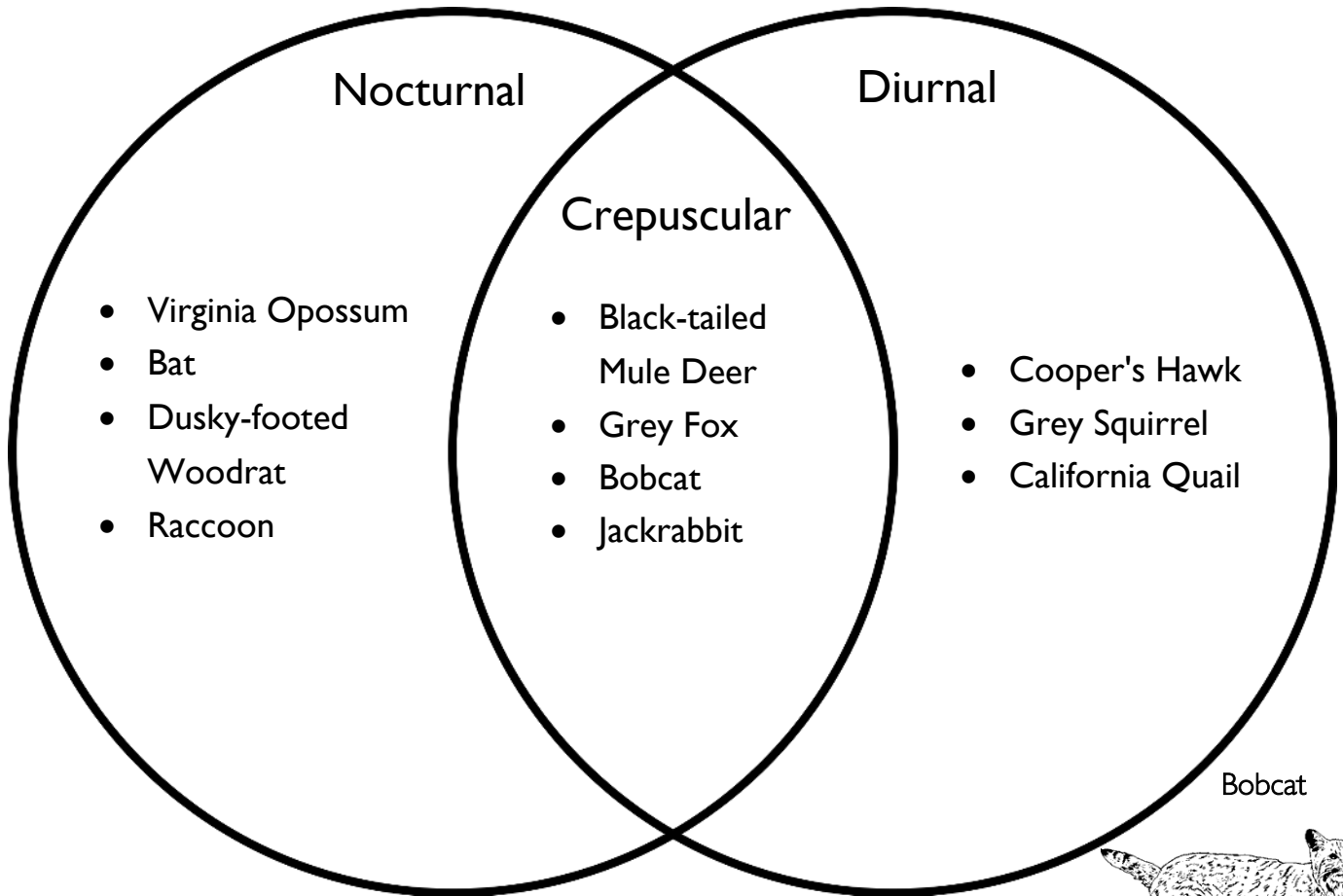
