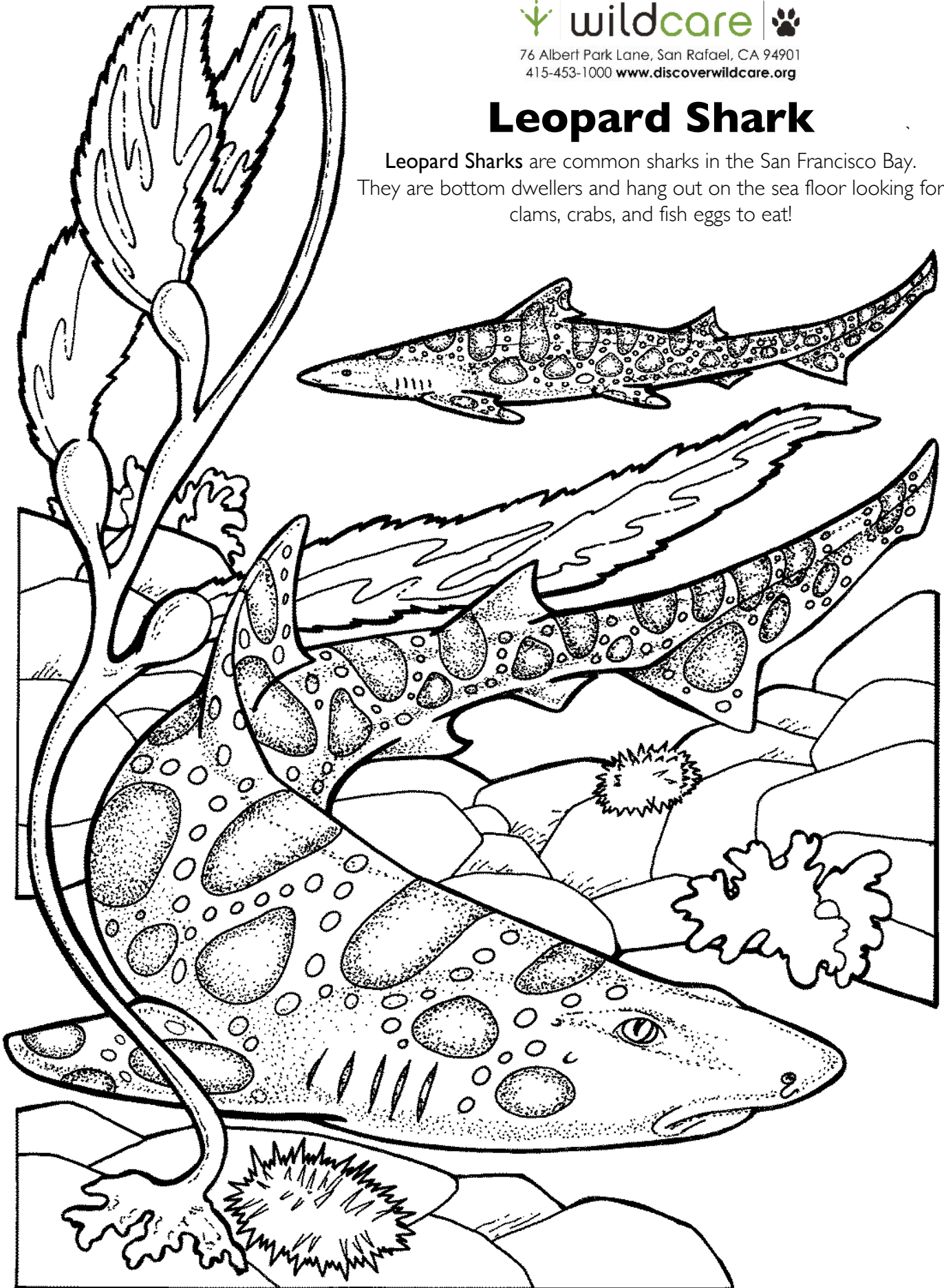
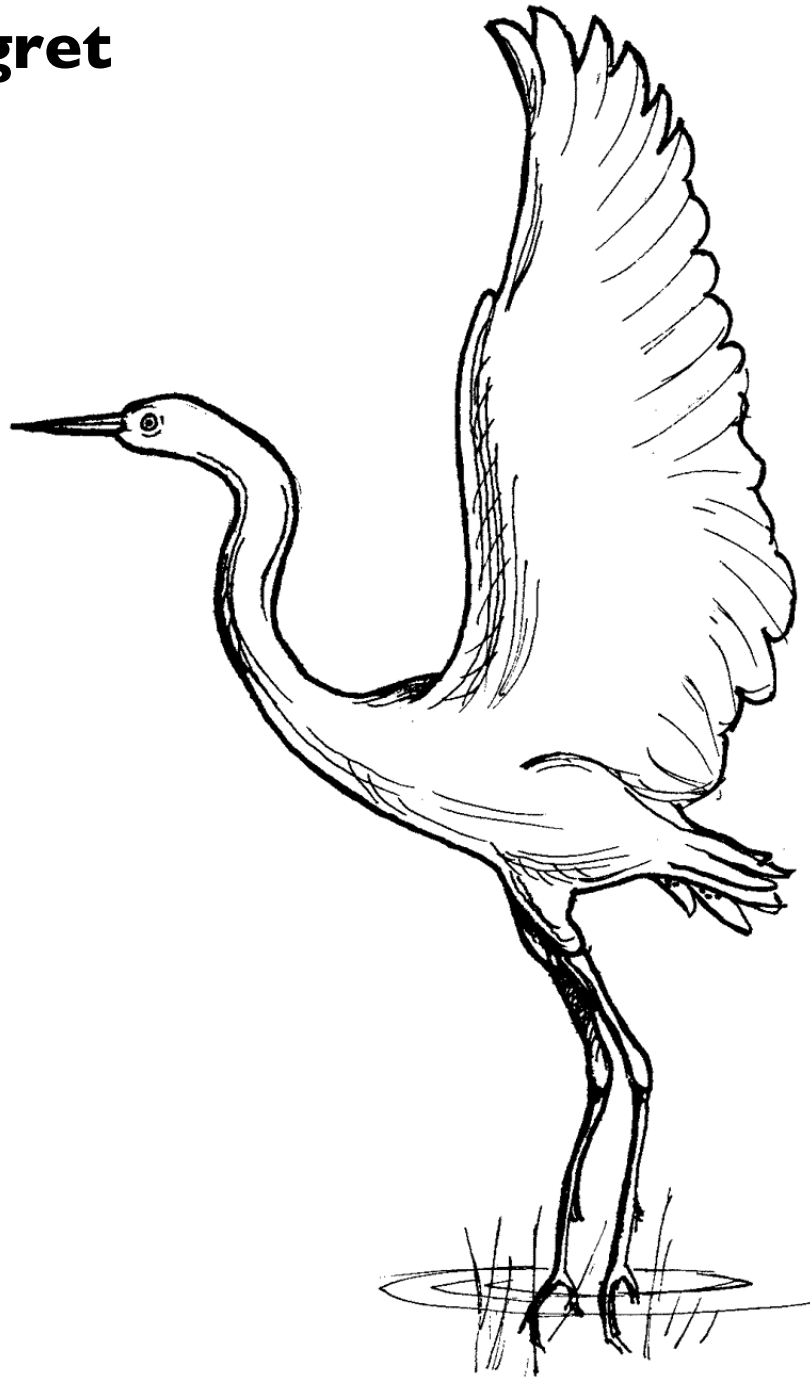


Leopard Shark

River Otter

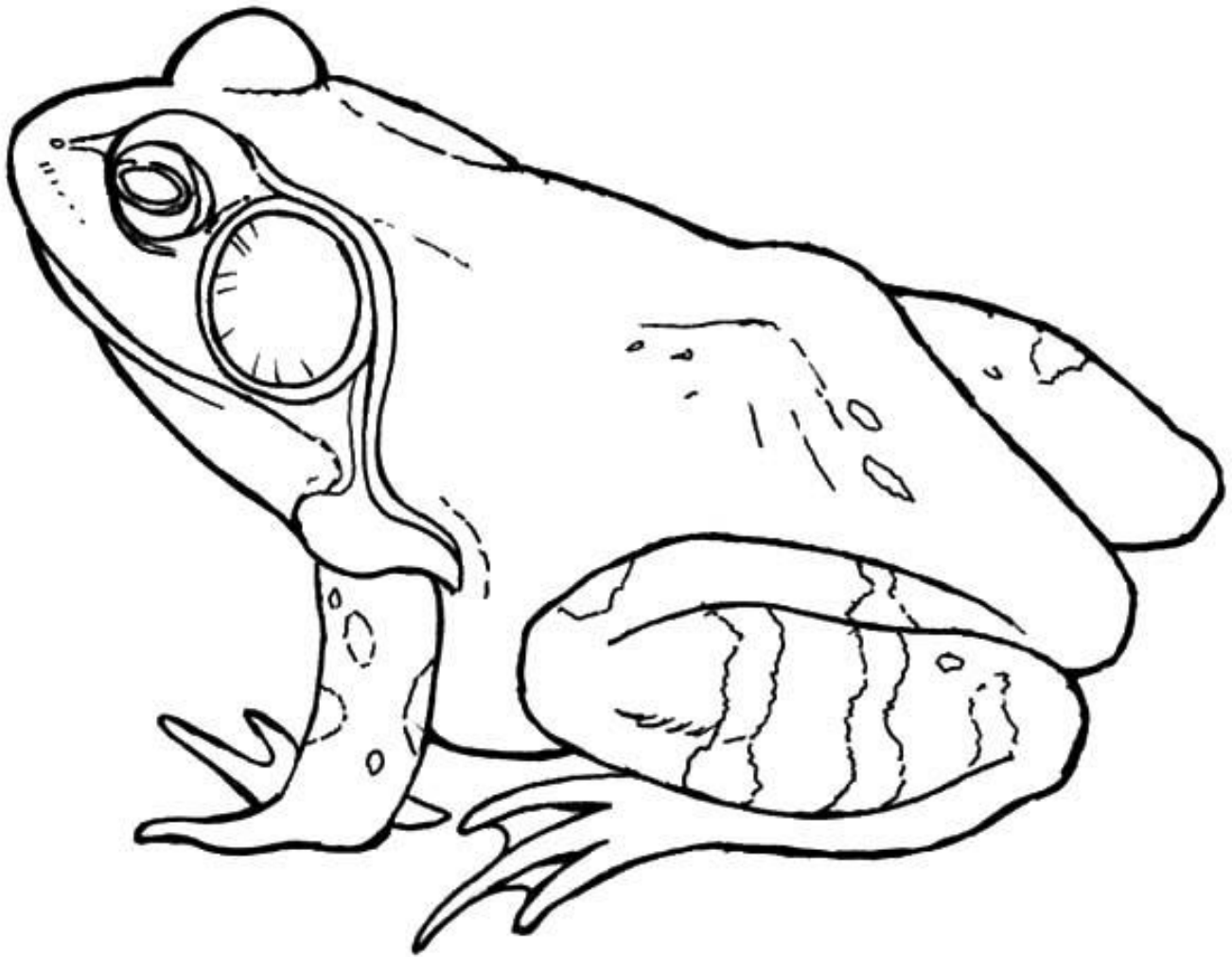


The **River Otter** chases fish underwater and rests on land inside a den.

American Avocet

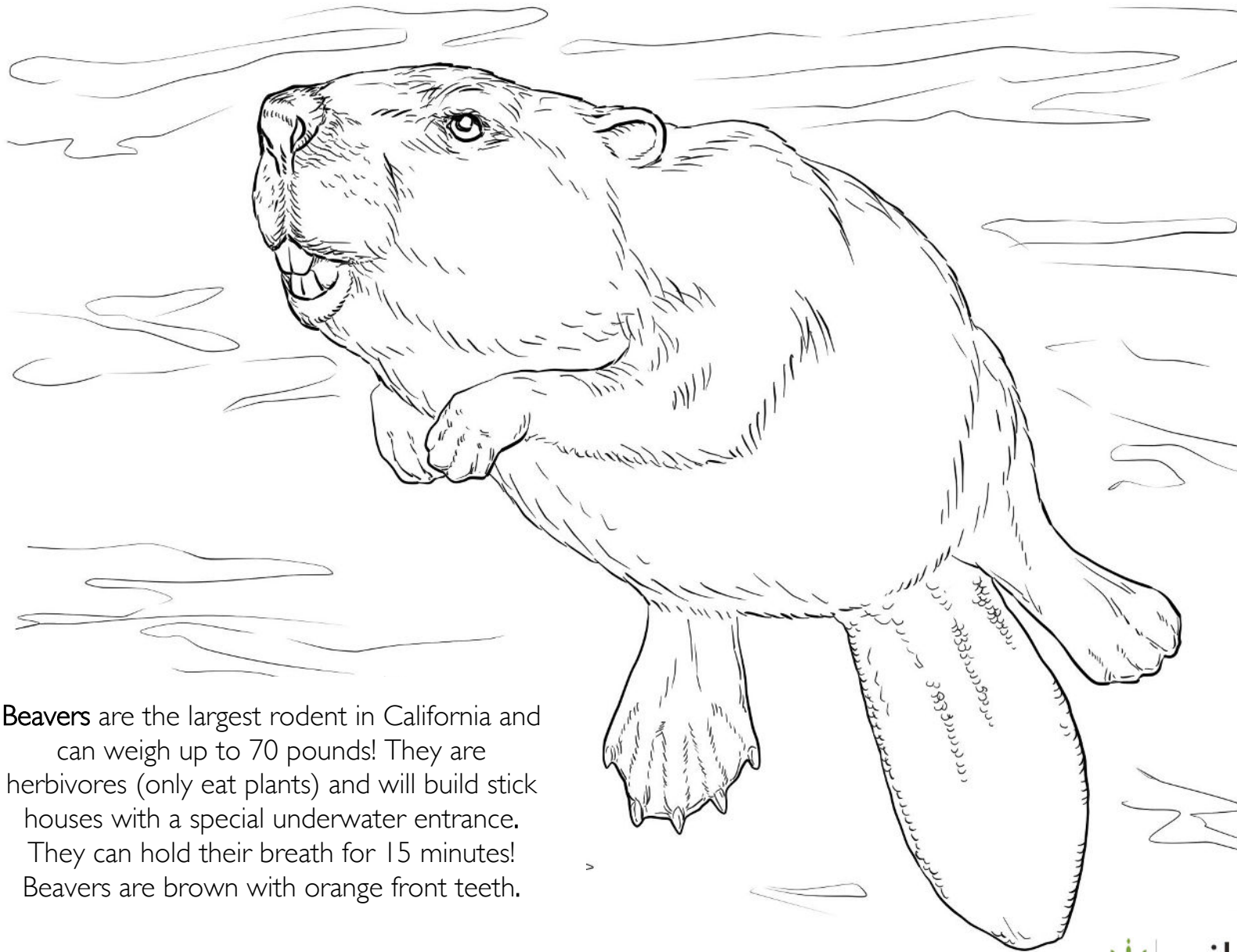
