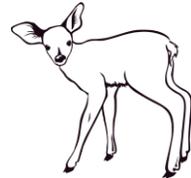
Try your hand at solving these *wild* math problems!

1. Multiply the number of legs on a Fox Squirrel by the number of legs on a Desert Tortoise.

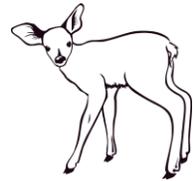
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7. Multiply the number of legs on a Fox Squirrel by the number of legs on a Desert Tortoise.

Count up the number of letters in your answer above and multiply that by the number of eyes on a fawn.

$$\underline{7} \times \underline{2} = \boxed{14}$$

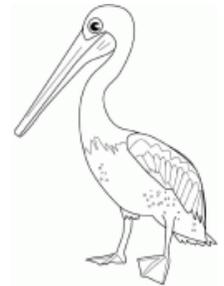


9. The Peregrine Falcon almost went extinct due to the use of the pesticide DDT. DDT was banned in the United States in 1972 and the Peregrine Falcon's numbers had finally increased enough to be removed from the Endangered Species List in 1999. How many years from the time of the ban did it take for the Peregrine Falcon to recover.

$$\underline{1999} - \underline{1972} = \boxed{27}$$

10. On average, a Brown Pelican can hold 3 gallons of water in its stretchy pouch. If there are five Brown Pelicans diving for fish, how many gallons of water could they hold total?

$$\underline{3} \times \underline{5} = \boxed{15}$$



11. A Northern Spotted Owl can have a wingspan up to 40 inches wide. A Western Screech Owl can have a wingspan up to 24 inches wide. How much wider is the Northern Spotted Owl's wingspan than the Western Screech Owl's wingspan?

$$\underline{40} - \underline{24} = \boxed{16}$$

12. If you talk to 5 people about taking care of wildlife, and each one of them talks to 2 people about taking care of wildlife, how many people will have learned about taking care of wildlife?

$$\underline{5} \times \underline{2} = \boxed{10} \quad + \text{ you} = \underline{11}$$
